## What do you need to know?

- Applications will open on 26 June 2017 and close on 9 August 2017.
- · Local councils and incorporated not-for-profit organisations are eligible to apply
- Project must:
  - o be for building/refurbishing infrastructure; or purchasing capital equipment items with a minimum individual value of \$2,500
  - o be completed by 31 March 2019.
- Applications are highly competitive with a total amount of \$300,000 available for each state electorate. As a guide, an average amount of \$20,000 is awarded to each successful project.
- Projects will be assessed against the program criteria by State Members of Parliament and Independent Review Panel members.
- Applicants will need to demonstrate how their project will promote local participation with positive social, environmental and recreational outcomes.
